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## FOREWORD

The Executive Committee of the Eastern Snow Conference is pleased to submit this copy of Proceedings, Volume 11 for your consideration. This is in keeping with the objective of the Conference "to collect, disseminate, and analyze data relating to snow and ice".

The Eastern Snow Conference is an informal group of business men, engineers, foresters, scientists and educators, from Northeastern United States and Eastern Canada, which meets annually at some pre-selected location in New England, New York or Canada.
